GRANT MAKING POLICY

Okehampton Hamlets Parish Council recognises the importance of supporting groups, organisations and charities that benefit the local community, and that making grants is a valuable method of support.

A total figure for available grant aid will be agreed by the Council as part of their budget for each financial year. Requests for grant aid will be considered on application of the correct grant form.

Requests for grant aid must satisfy the following conditions:-

- Any group or organisation applying for a grant must demonstrate that the funding would directly serve the needs of the village.
- Grants may be made to:
 - Okehampton Hamlets Parish based non-political, non-profit making groups, organisations, educational establishments or charities;
 - Local or national groups or organisations, provided there is a direct benefit to Okehampton Hamlets Parish.
- Only applications made on the appropriate grant aid form will be considered. The form is available from the clerk: hard copy or by email.
- Details of how the grant will be used will be required from each applicant.
- Up to date accounts may be required to support the application.
